2 Ball Ambrose

Ambrose is a team's event based on a stroke format. It is a mixed gender competition and visitors with a GA handicap are eligible to enter.

Each player in the team hits from the tee and then mutually agree the better ball, a good idea is to appoint a captain in case of disputes.

To play the better ball the position is first marked, and the other team players PLACE their ball within a handspan of the mark. Shots can be played in any order.

Their next stroke is hit from this position, no matter where their previous stroke finished. The captain makes a similar selection for all subsequent strokes. If the selected ball is in the rough or a penalty area, the other ball must be placed in the rough or penalty area. On the putting green the ball is placed within a handspan of the selected better ball.

Teams shall consist of 2 players, and the handicap is the total of the 2 players divided by 4. If a group has 3 players, the 3rd player will need to enter the alternate daily competition or manually submit a card for handicap.


A minimum of 5 tee shots per player must be used. The honor system is to be used to ensure teams use 5 tee shots from each player

Scoring is to be completed using either MiScore on your phone or results entered into the kiosk. Paper cards will only be processed if the entire field is using manual scoring.

Teams are automatically set in MiScore by the position of the bookings in the timesheet. Players 1 & 2 are paired, as are 3 & 4.



If a group has 3 players, the Ambrose pair need to be in position 1&2 and the third player can be in any position.
