4BBB Stableford

4BBB Stableford is a team's event based on a Stableford format. It is a mixed gender competition and visitors with a GA handicap are eligible to enter.

Two players play as a 2-partner team and must play in the same group. Each player finishes the hole with their own ball using individual handicaps. The second player should pick up if they cannot better the team-mate's score.

Teams are automatically set in MiScore by the position of the bookings in the timesheet. Players 1 & 2 are paired, as are 3 & 4. Players MUST play in this order or the scores will be incorrect and disqualified.



The player with the better score on the hole, or the first to finish in the event of equal score is selected in MiScore, and the number of strokes recorded. MiScore calculates the Stableford points. The same is performed for the other team.

Only one player per team records the scores in MiScore and this should be the person in position 1 for the team from the timesheet.



If it isn't possible to avoid playing as a 3-ball, then the lowest handicapper ("swinger") will automatically partner the other 2 players. At the end of the round, MiScore will automatically assign the swinger.

In the event that there is a swinger, the swinger cannot enter scores, the other 2 players are required to score.

Remember that our 4BBB events are more social than sheep-stations.
